Dear Parents/ Carers,

We will text you the **PASSWORD** to access this area just after **EASTER**. There will be a clear timetable for work here for every year group and lots of downloadable worksheets, links to apps, games, learning videos and so much more support. There will even be a little surprise from staff for our little pupils in here too, as staff miss our little children so much indeed. More information about this will be texted to you so do not worry!

In the meantime though, it is **EASTER**. It is a time to relax, take stock, make family time really quality time for the duration of the holidays and simply enjoy each other. Turn off computers, put away the Home Learning Packs for now and take time out just to chill. Better days will come...we just need to work through this together and we will get there. 
We all send big hugs and special Easter Blessings to our little pupils (we miss you so much!) and hope that the Easter Bunny can bring something a little special for Easter Sunday!
