The purpose of The Arts within the Primary Curriculum, therefore, to provide opportunities for children to develop:

- their curiosity, imagination and creativity,
- their self confidence and self esteem,
- their artistic, musical and kinaesthetic abilities, including gross and fine motor skills,
- verbal and non-verbal modes of expression,
- an appreciation of the beauty and wonder of the world around them,
- their ability to make informed choices and decisions,
- an awareness of other cultures
