Year 2 - Foundation Stage Term 1	
Dear Parent, I hope your child is having a good year so far, despite the current pandemic. Things are really exciting in our school for our Foundation Stage children. As you know we have a planned, highly structured curriculum for your child. We want to involve you in your child's education so this newsletter is to inform you of what your child will be studying in school this term. You can support your child by also discussing these curriculum areas at home. Literacy	
<b>Phonics</b> Your child will be covering stage 1 and 2 of the Linguistic Phonics WELB programme. The key focus this term is letter sound correspondence. Please reinforce sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, o, c, k, and new sounds f, r, u, d, h, g, b You can use these sounds to create simple words.	<b>Reading</b> Your child will read through the different stages of the Oxford Reading Tree scheme started in P1. It is always a good idea to enrol your child in the local town library and borrow/read books with him regularly.
Keywords Your child will be learning keywords/sounds each week and will be tested on them. Some words will be easy to sound out and others they just need to remember. An idea would be to put each word onto a piece of card and look at the sounds to sound out. Mix the cards up. Revise previous weeks. What can your child remember? Another idea is to place the cards out and play 'Ispy with my little eye something beginning with c' or 'show me the word can'. Play snap. Make multiple copies of the words to play. They love this in school and it really helps them learn! You can do this for sounds too.	Writing For your child to begin to write we will be working on letter/sound representation. Your child will be learning what a sentence is and that it starts with a capital letter and ends with a full stop. We are promoting independent writing. If your child makes something of interest make a label for it. Ask him/her to stretch out the word to hear the sounds. Then begin to write the sounds 1 by 1. It isn't important to get the spelling right at this point. What's important is that they have a go to match the sounds to letters.
Numeracy   Your child will have the opportunity to develop their numeracy skills and will be covering   numbers to 20 and beyond, identifying 2D/3D shapes, begin to understand time and understand   measure & data handling.   ICT   In ICT your child will be using the keyboard to type their name and change the font colour. They	

In ICT your child will be using the keyboard to type their name and change the font colour. They will create a self-portrait, Christmas cards, using online programmes on the Interactive White-Board and a range of iPad apps to support learning. They will develop their mouse control skills. They will also have the opportunity to use the Bee-bot (Our programmable robot) to programme

Reinforce new sounds introduced in school f, r, u, d, h, g, b

Use sounds to create new words, practice making words from key word booklet
