### **Updated School Attendance Policy**

Our little children should be encouraged to keep their attendance **NO LESS THAN 90%**. If attendance falls below 90% then a letter will be sent from school to raise awareness. It is understood that from time to time children may have illness which prevents them from coming to school. If this happens your child please let the school know as soon as possible and send a WRITTEN NOTE with your child explaining the absence when they return to school so that teachers can change the attendance code on the computer system which reflects this explanation. If your child experiences any other issues that prevents them from being able to attend school, please approach the teacher immediately and all efforts will be made to help and support. Remember if your child misses school, they miss out! (Please note that attendance at Nursery is not compulsory but we encourage good school attendance practices for all our little pupils!)

### **PATHS Quote of the Month December**



#### Tickets: (PLEASE COMPLETE ATTACHED TICKET PURCHASE SHEET)

Each child from Nursery - Year 3 will have THREE tickets reserved for them.

St. Patrick's Hall has enough seats to allow for each child from Nursery, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 pupils to have THREE tickets each. Tickets will cost £5 each.

This year to avoid stress (of queueing to seek tickets) for our parents, we are sending home a reply slip to enable each child to have their family purchase their THREE tickets in advance in school. When the reply slip is returned with the amount of tickets indicated and money sent, we will send the tickets home.

The THREE tickets can be purchased all for the same night or the THREE tickets can be split between the two nights for example TWO for one night and ONE for another night etc. It must be noted however that due to the seat allocation in St. Patrick's Hall, each child (Nursery – Year 3 )can only have THREE tickets purchased at this point. All tickets should be paid for when the reply slip is returned. The reply slip should be returned NO LATER THAN TUESDAY 3<sup>rd</sup> DECEMBER.

If all reply slips are not returned / purchased by WEDNESDAY 4<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, any tickets not claimed will be released for sale on a first come first served basis from the offices on each site.

# Arrangements for the nights of our Nativity Show in St. Patrick's Hall

Each child from Nursery – Year 3 should arrive at St. Patrick's Hall at 6.30pm and enter via the side STAGE DOOR. Staff will be waiting for children upstairs in the Minor Hall. Children should arrive at the hall in their show clothes as outlined by the class teacher. Children should then be collected again from the hall at 8.30pm approx..

#### **Strabane Feis**

It's that time of year again......we are a school that places so much emphasis on providing a variety of opportunities for our children's learning. We promote a love of learning in the classroom and beyond for all subjects, sport music and drama too! Feis promotes confidence and aptitude in Speech and Language, Drama and Music in particular. It is quite a skill to get up in front of an audience to say a poem, make a speech, sing a song or play an instrument! Regardless of what level each child can perform at, we acknowledge the effort that any child makes in order to take part in the Feis..... this is overcoming fear at such a young age and promoting a skill that will serve our children well in the future! We encourage all our children from Nursery – Year 7 to take part in the Feis events and teachers will encourage and promote this in school also!

There is a Speech Feis and a Music Feis.

Speech Feis will take place from Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> February to Monday 2nd March.

Music Feis will take place from Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March to Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March.

# Cost of Individual Entry to the Feis will be £1.50. The closing Date for entries to the Feis will be Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January.

Sometimes we notice that children do not enter the Feis by the closing date and then when they hear all the children rehearsing for Feis in school, they want to enter then but its too late! We advise that children strongly consider entering by the closing date as they will be guaranteed to enjoy it and join in the fun of it with their class in the lead up to the event itself!

All children who enter the Feis will get a certificate of participation from school..... regardless of the adjudicator's decision in St. Patrick's Hall!!

The poems and songs for the Feis will be sent out after Christmas.
