


Holy Communion Postponed





Summer Uniform

Every year, children may wear their Summer Uniform when the weather gets a little warmer. Therefore children may wear their Summer Uniform (only if they choose to) from **Monday 10th May after the May Break.**

It is to be noted also that little Nursery Pupils (poloshirt with logo, sweatshirt with logo and navy jogging bottoms) wear the same Uniform all year round.


